



KinderGym – Sibling Policy

Purpose

This policy ensures a safe and focused environment for all participants by managing the presence of siblings during KinderGym gymnastics classes.

Scope

Applies to all families attending KinderGym classes and programs at Brighton Recreational Centre.

Policy

1. Minimising Sibling Attendance

Siblings are not permitted in KinderGym classes whenever possible.

2. Multiple Guardians

Where multiple guardians are present, one guardian must accompany siblings to the designated upstairs viewing/play area to keep them occupied.

3. Older Siblings

- Must remain in the designated 'sibling zone' as directed by coaching staff.
- Guardians are responsible for providing an activity to occupy older siblings during the class.
- Older siblings are not permitted to participate in the KinderGym class or use equipment at any time, including during free time at the conclusion of activities.

4. Younger Siblings

- Must be in a secure carrier or pram that allows the guardian to assist the participating child.
- If short-term attention is required, guardians must inform the class coach so appropriate supervision of the participating child can be maintained.

Responsibility

Parents and guardians are responsible for supervising siblings according to this policy. Coaching staff are responsible for monitoring compliance and ensuring a safe environment for all participants.

Compliance

Failure to adhere to this policy may result in staff requesting siblings be removed from the class environment to maintain safety and program integrity.
